

Digital Photography Scavenger Hunt

Objective: Students will use manual exposure mode to take properly exposed photographs.

While shooting in Manual (M) Mode, you will have to control all 3 aspects of the exposure triangle: ISO, Shutter & Aperture, and make sure that they are all properly balanced to give you a correct exposure.

Remember:

- **ISO** controls your camera's sensitivity to light and image quality (noise)
- **Shutter** controls your exposure and how you capture motion
- **Aperture** controls your exposure and depth of field

Photograph the following images/techniques:

It is your job to make whatever you are photographing interesting, inspiring, exciting, new and unique! Think outside the box!

- 1.) Shoot someone jumping in the air... freeze the action
- 2.) Shoot tangled wires
- 3.) Shoot something from the ground level
- 4.) Shoot something from a higher level (be careful)!
- 5.) Shoot something yellow
- 6.) Shoot an eye or eyes
- 7.) Shoot something in the distance
- 8.) Shoot a reflection
- 9.) Shoot 3 photographs of hands and feet/shoes, together or separate
- 10.) Shoot a view through something (window, door, etc.)
- 11.) Shoot the action of laughing
- 12.) Shoot garbage
- 13.) Shoot an accident waiting to happen
- 14.) Shoot a crack in the floor/ground
- 15.) Shoot time
